Oamar & the rope of forgiveness



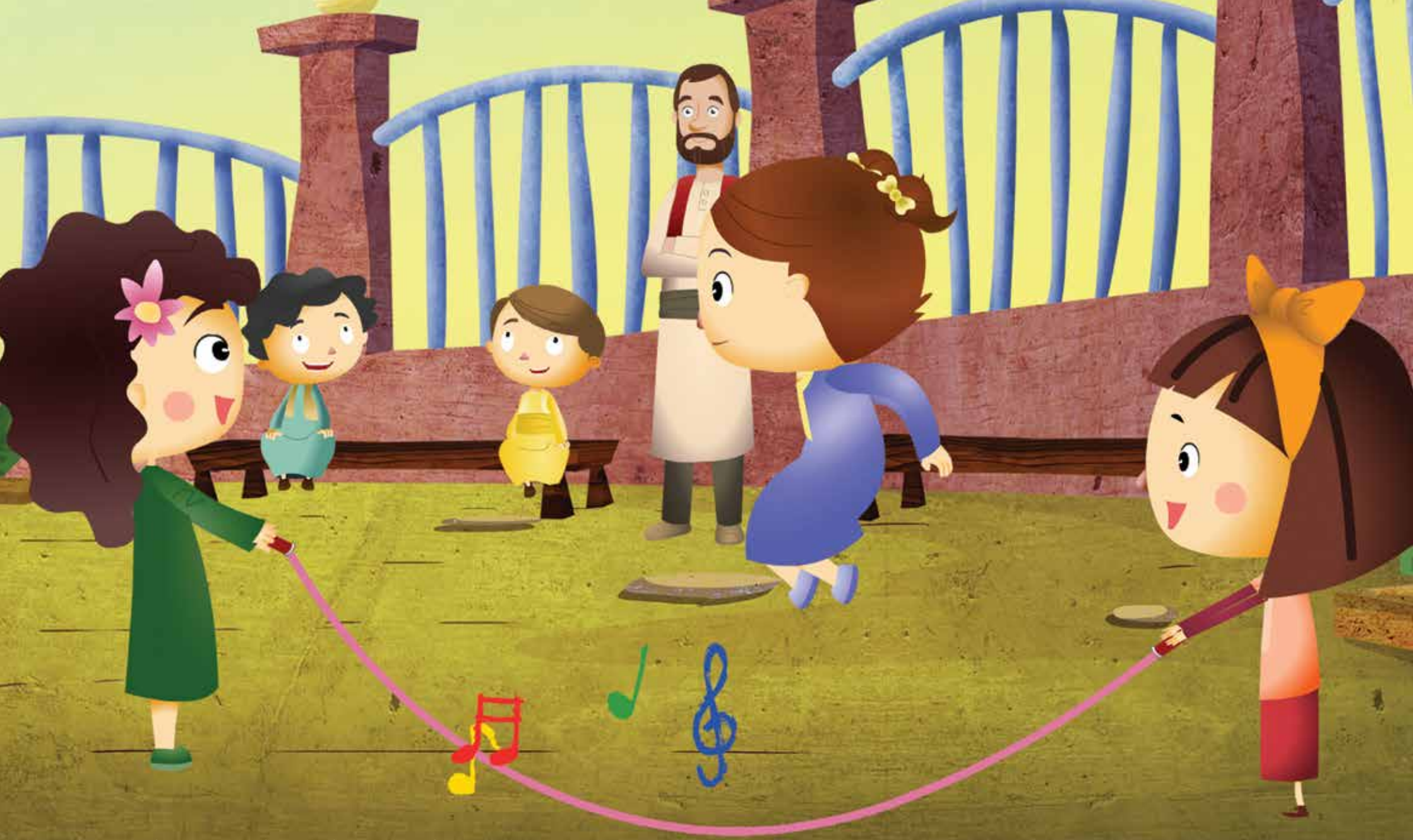


Once upon a time, there was a little girl named Qamar who lived in a beautiful town.



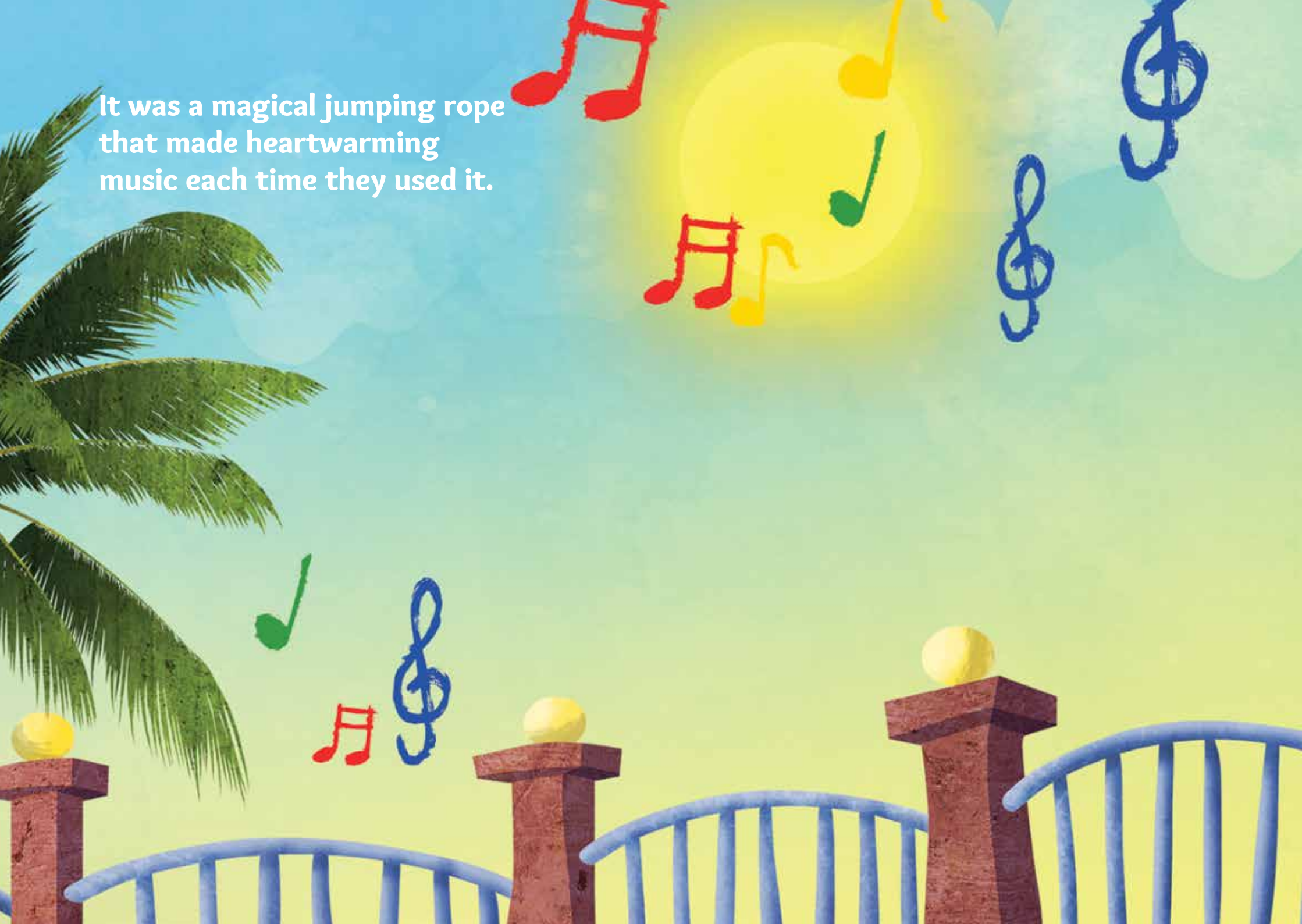
Qamar had two inseparable friends... Heba and Layla.

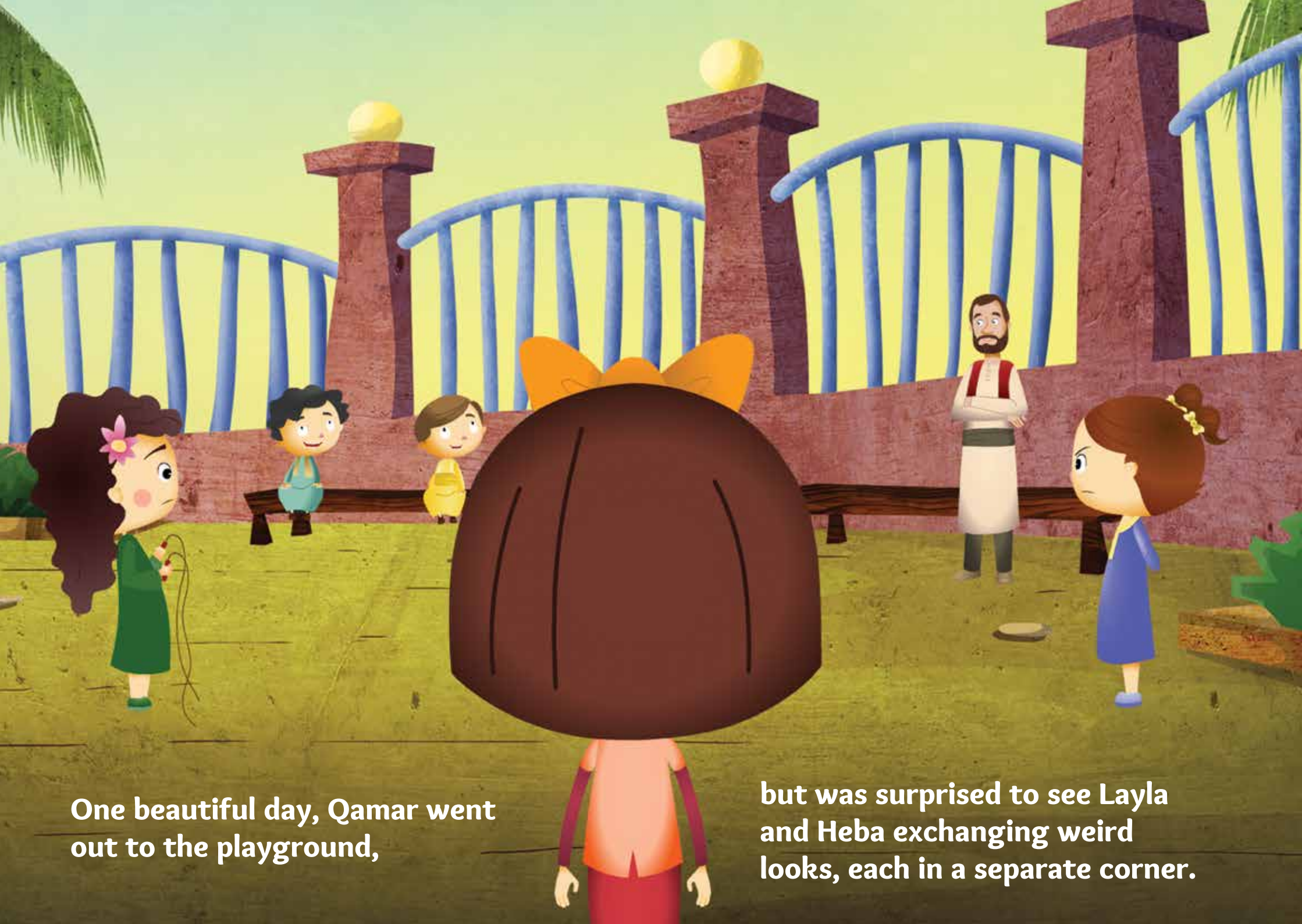




They always played together,

colorful jumping rope.

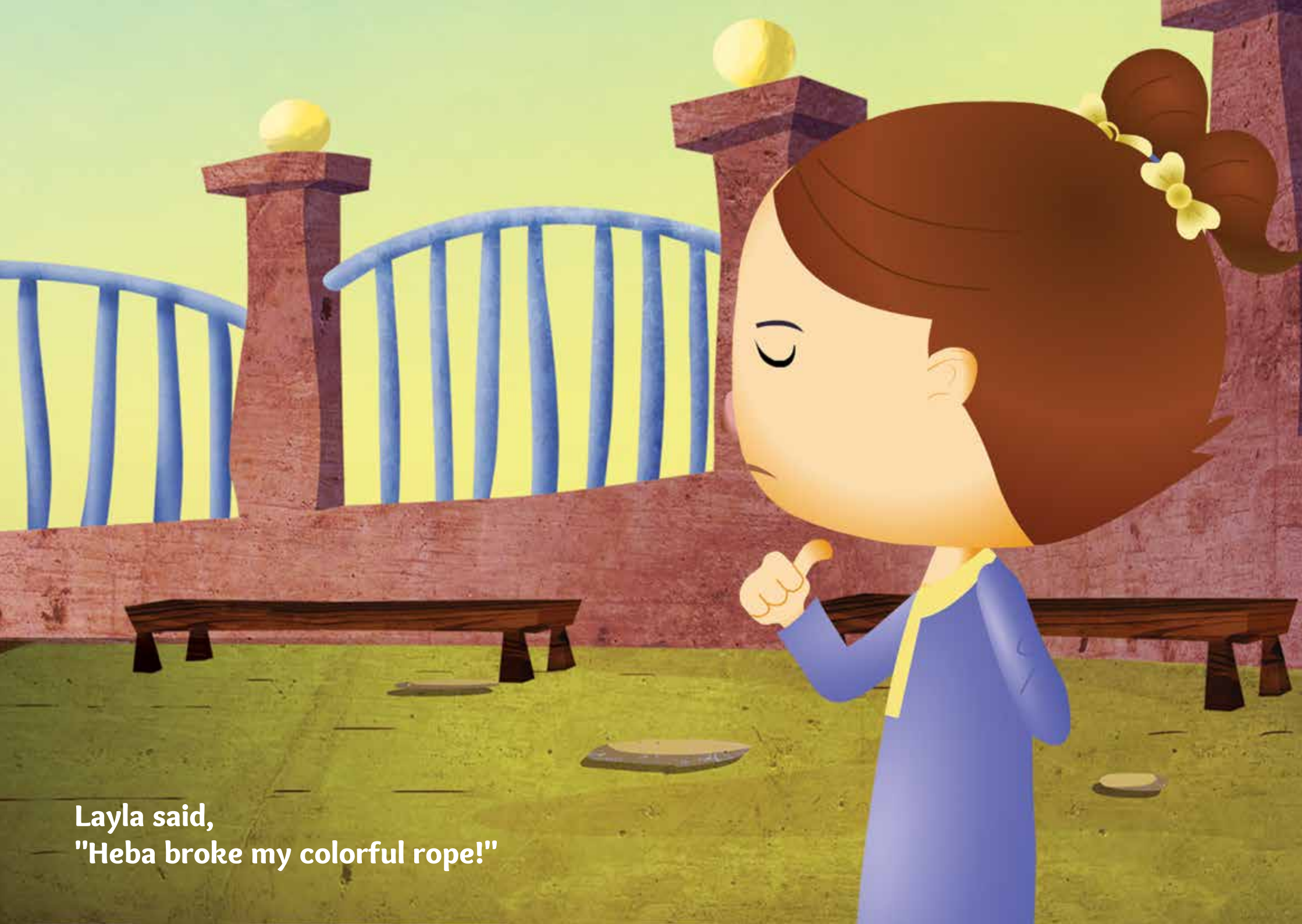
It was a magical jumping rope that made heartwarming music each time they used it.

but was surprised to see Layla and Heba exchanging weird looks, each in a separate corner.

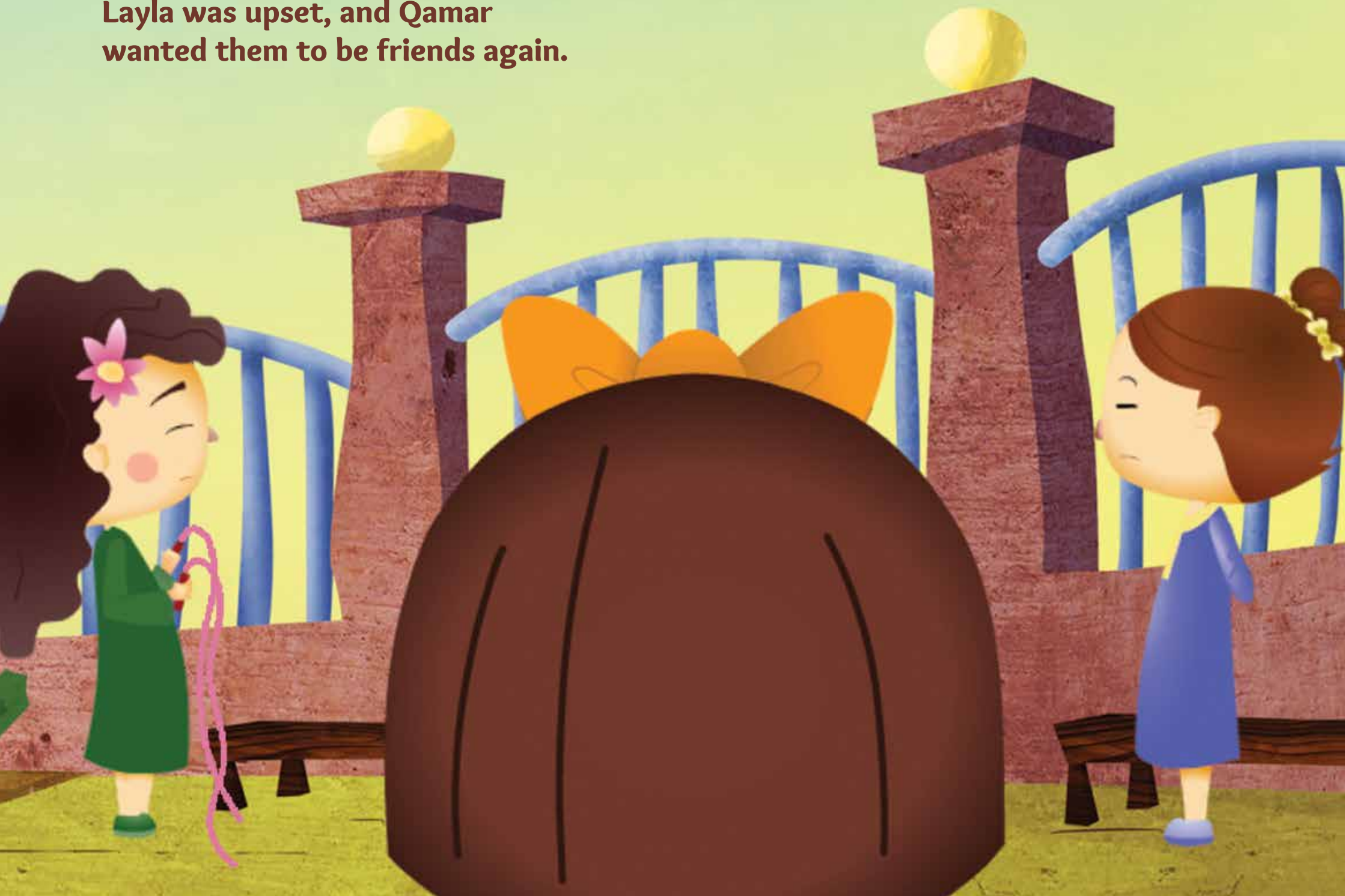


Layla said,
